

Who Am I?

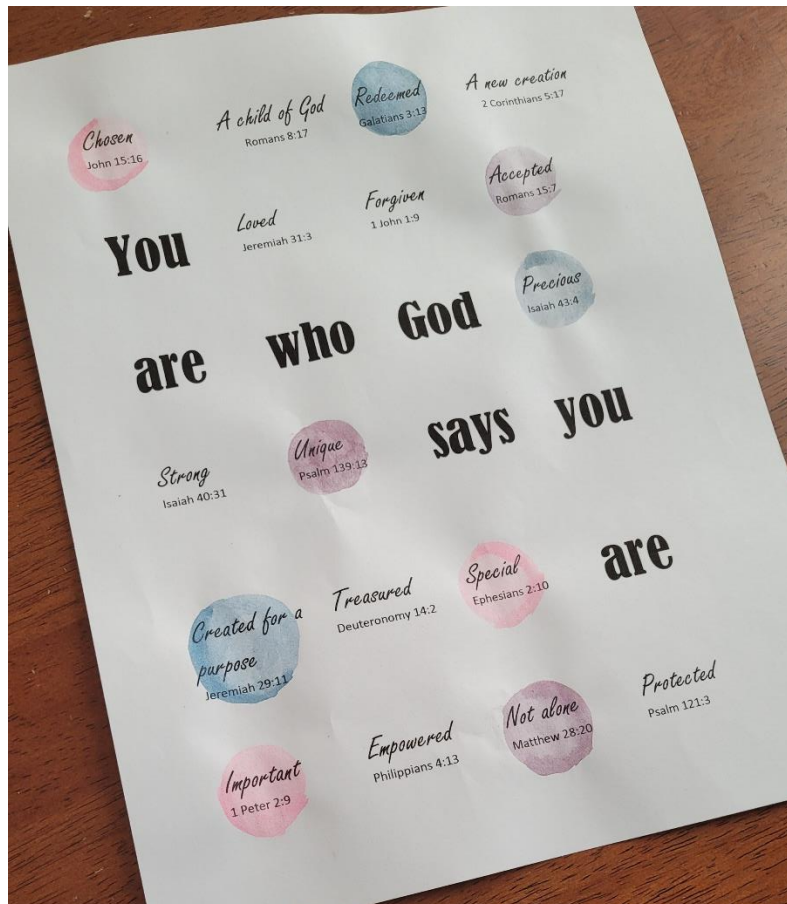

This page can be used to help teach student who the Bible says we are. Exploring these scriptures can help students find their identity in Christ and the truth about who he says we are instead of trying to find ourselves in what the world has to offer.

This lesson was originally created for a middle school girls Sunday School class based on other ideas which were found in online resources. It could be used for older students, adults, small groups, and individuals.

The class spent two class periods reading and discussing the scriptures. Time was given at the end of each lesson for students to paint over the verses which were just discussed. The page was printed on white cardstock and the students used water color paints.

At the end of the unit, students were encouraged to take the page home and hang it in their room at home to help them remember who God says they are.
